
ORDERED and DECREED that:

1. The Clarification Motion is **GRANTED** to the extent provided herein; and
2. That certain Consigned Stock Agreement, as amended, between Allied and the Debtors’ Atwood Division, dated March 1998, and assumed by the Debtors’ Atwood Division by virtue of this Court’s Order dated March 20, 2007 (docket no. 856), was assigned to Atwood Mobile Products, LLC f/k/a Atwood

LLC, as Purchaser, and Atwood Mobile Products, Inc., as Seller, as approved by this Court by virtue of the Order entered August 15, 2007 (docket no. 1659) authorizing the sale of the Debtors' Atwood Mobile Products Division.
